- **SAN FRANCISCO:** Alaska, Northern California (excluding the following counties: Imperial, Inyo, Kern, Los Angeles, Orange, San Bernardino, San Diego, San Luis Obispo, Santa Bárbara and Ventura included in the jurisdiction of the Consulate General of Spain in Los Angeles), Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, Washington, Wyoming, and the Pacific Island.

IMPORTANT NOTES IF YOU APPLY FOR YOUR STUDENT VISA @ L.A. or SFO

- 1.- You cannot apply for your student visa until you receive an original letter from the Comunidad Autonoma (faxes are not admitted).
- 2.- Certification of "absence of police records" should be an original form with the Apostille of the Hague.
- 3.- To receive the passport back with the visa, please enclose a prepaid US Postal Express Mail envelope with appropriate postage (\$16.25) and completed air bill. Be sure you keep a copy of the tracking number for your records.
- 4.- If you apply for your visa in **San Francisco**, you should set up an appointment on line, just in case the system gives you a date later than August 15, you should contact the Education Office in Los Angeles (javier.dehiges@mec.es).
